MISSIONARY ACTIVITY IN AN IMMIGRANT SHIP SAILING FROM ODESSA TO HAIFA

"OPERATION JABOTINSKY" OF A CHRISTIAN CHURCH AROUSES WORRY

The Christian factors are planning an operation, through which thousands of immigrants from the CIS would come to Israel. The operation is financed by Christian bodies who see in bringing Jews to Israel an important mission in their faith.

Lately a Canadian Christian millionaire donated a sum of million dollars for purchase of a ship to bring immigrants to Israel. The ship would sail twice a month from Odessa to Israel and would bring in it, without payment, immigrants from the CIS. The accommodation would be at the expense of the Scandinavian church in Sweden and Finland. They have opened for this purpose many offices all over Georgia, Kazachstan and Armenia. The Jewish Agency supports this operation, calling it "Operation Jabotinsky", by name of Ze'ev Jabotinsky who called for the return of all the Jews to Israel.

Factors fighting against mission claim that there exists suspicion about missionary activities during the sail. Their messenger followed in the past in a similar journey from Odessa to Haifa, discovering that during the whole voyage the immigrants were handed over to the missionary activities of the Christians, who also asked the immigrants to keep in contact with them even after the voyage. In the end the organization, which also was assisted by the Jewish Agency, stopped its sails. "Lev le-achim" will fight with all means against the voyages of the ship.

Member of Knesset, Rabbi Yitshaq Levi, said that in the case it would really be discovered missionary activity during the voyage, they would inform the Knesset about this, and demand the cessation of the support of the Jewish Agency to the voyages. He said also that he would try, with the Members of Knesset Rabitz and Porat, to change the Law of Return, because, according to him, today even the secular people understand the problems connected with the immigration of immigrants who are not Jewish.

COOPERATION AGAINST COOPERATION

During the last months several attacks have been made against the offices of the anti-missionary organizations "Yad le-achim" and "Lev le-achim".

Unknown persons attacked the branch of the activist organization "Yad le-achim" in Netanyah, removing the mezuzas from the entrance door of the office and damaging the door. They fled from the place after having also removed the mail box from its place.

Rabbi Holtzman, the director of the branch, lodged yesterday a complaint to police, pointing at a number of missionary groups, with the suspicion that they performed the deed.

3 months ago a similar sabotage was done in the branch. In that case the mail box and the outside name-plates of the branch were stolen.

In the case of breaking in to the center of "Lev le-achim" in Netanyah, the police investigation has got new guidelines in connection with the radio program broadcasted a day before the crime, in which there was informed both about the cooperation of the religious and the kibbutz circles against the sects and missionaries and about the secret information about the sects contained in the offices of "Lev le-achim". The first fact removes the fight against the sects out of the religious stigma and places it to the national level.

After entering to the offices of the administration of the organization the criminals destroyed all the cupboards, and tried also to break in to the safe in which the information about the Mission and the sects is hold, but did not succeed. Also, an attempt had been made to enter to the data bank of the computer system.

The Department for Fight against Mission gave to the police details about the missionary groups and sects about which there exists suspicion that they had interest in getting the material which lays in the

Members of a missionary sect, calling itself "People of strength" (according to Hed ha-Qriyot, Messianic Jews), distributed on the beaches of Qiryat Yam propaganda leaflets about their activities, from which it rose that they profess different fighting skills and vigor. "Those who choose to follow God will be spiritual fighters gaining victory over vice. Jesus of Nazareth was a spiritual fighter like that, he lived a life of love, of power and of spiritual strength", it is written in the propaganda leaflets, which were accompanied by pictures of Judo and Karate fighters.

The missionaries tried to recruit mainly new immigrants from the CIS. After many complaints about their activity, on the place were alarmed the inspectors of the municipality of Qiryat Yam, who tried to disperse the group, but without success. The exchange of words turned to a fight, which reinforcements of the overseers coming to the place succeeded in controlling.

Mayor of Qiryat Yam, Shmuel Siso, discussed the possibility to take juridical steps against the members of the sect with the Ministry of Religious Affairs, but a decision on the subject has not yet been made. The municipality of Qiryat Yam also demanded from the Ministry to act against the members of the sect.

Mayor of Migdal ha-Emeq, the Member of Knesset Shaul Amur, sent this week a letter to the highest superior of the police in the Northern



District, in which he asks to prevent the association of "Awakening to life" and its helpers from actions "which are liable to cause Migdal ha-Emeq to get back down to its darkest days". He pointed out that the municipality of Migdal ha-Emeq made great efforts for the association, which, however, decided that this was not enough, and performed a series of actions which are liable to cause the town to return to its darkest days, the seventies, the period of violence. Amur requests them to act quickly, strongly and with all the legal means standing in the use of the District police in order to uproot this kind of activities completely.

One of the activities about which the Mayor spoke about in his letter was the setting up of a cross, of the height of three meters, on the top of the house, on which is drawn Jesus from Nazareth. This act is actually a protest action against the Mayor and against the Rabbi of the municipality, Rabbi David Grossman.

The director-general of the company "Awakening to life", David Levi, said that he is going to bring Migdal ha-Emeq back to the fifties, because, by returning back to the problems of the transit camps (for new immigrants), it is perhaps possible to start all over again, and to "put the politicians back to their natural place". He accuses the Mayor and R. Grossman of wanting to destroy the narcoman treatment community and of wanting to have narcomans in the town, claiming that if Rabbi Grossman represents the Jewish religion, then he prefers to be Christian, and threatening to establish a Christian sect and churches to the whole Migdal ha-Emeq.

Mayor of Migdal ha-Emeq, Shaul Amur, said that numbers prove how they have assisted the association. According to him, it obtained 60,000 shekels from the authority for War against Drugs, and still 30,000 shekels from the municipality. Amur supposes that the tumult is political, with the intention to operate pressure on him as a result of the present relations of power in Likud.

Lately 7 Ethiopian immigrant families in Nazareth were converted to Christianity. The activists of Mission exploited their difficult financial situation, and after they had assisted them financially, they consented to get converted. As a result of this, the Religious Council in Nazareth initiated an extra meeting in which participated the Ethiopian religious leaders from all over the country. These declared war against the Mission and expressed their readiness for explanation activity of the leaders of the community among additional immigrants who are under the influence of the missionaries. They recommended also to remove from the area the Falashmureans coming from the settlements and

helping the missionaries in their activities.

The head of the Ethiopian religious leaders claimed that the immigrants do not have any reason to get converted to Christianity, because the ministries of the Government help the families in distress as much as possible.

Also the neighbors of the residents who got converted complained severely against those who were persuaded by the missionaries. The neighbors claimed that the converted ones deceived the authorities, who took care of their immigration to Israel without sparing their efforts. At the same time they told them not to stay any more in the area and to try to capture additional immigrants to the Mission net. The chairman of the Religious Council in Nazareth, Menachem Waqnin, says that in spite of the open action of the Mission, it is not possible to remove them from the city by law and to prohibit their activity.





The material has been distributed also in other parts of the city, even in the religious areas, where the missionaries wear ultra-Orthodox clothes.
